HOW DO WE START?

The primary criteria to participate in Multiplus as a multiplier was to work actively with or from an immigrant community. If this work was carried out from an NGO or privately, whether the multiplier had the same migration background as his/her group were not relevant criteria to participate in Multiplus as multiplier.

If Europe were a person, how would we describe her or him? It sounds almost impossible! Europe's physical characteristics (geography) and its ways (languages, traditions, cultures and economies) are so different that we can conclude that they are many different people in one.

So, what is it that causes Europe, and more precisely the EU, to be perceived as a unit and often referred to have a common identity? Is the EU then more than a political and economic alliance? What does it mean for an immigrant to live on EU soil?

These questions are among the starting points to talk about the values that the EU proclaims as its own as well as asks its member states to take on and defend.

Migrant Multipliers Build Bridges


The European Union was founded to promote peace, its values and the welfare of all its inhabitants. Precisely these values, like a creed, are fundamentally and in principle those that aim to unify Europeans' experience of a common sense of belonging. The idea is also that these values encircle and include all citizens in Europe, regardless of immigration background, gender, age, religion, sexual orientation, education, ability, etc.

However, do all residents of Europe, with particular emphasis on residents of the European Union (EU), share an experience of such value-based belonging and recognition?

It is a well-known fact that not all inhabitants of today's Europe feel a sense of belonging or human recognition as the EU proclaims as fundamental values. This is the main reason why the MultiPLUS project has put human rights and related concepts on the agenda in the last learning/training program for the local Multipliers in the partner countries.

The aim is that the Multipliers themselves, after completing the training program, would be able to continue to convey these basic values in their own communities. Through critical debate and thinking, the goal is for European residents of migrant communities to collectively reflect on how they experience these fundamental values and rights in their own everyday lives.

In May 2022 we assisted to the third transnational partner meeting in Ljubljana (TPM3), a meeting where we spoke about the project implementation, we evaluated the IO2 and the entire process of implementation including the online resources of the toolbox, and gave space for starting Be Part Plus, the third phase of Multiplus. The TPM3 served to adjust the implementation of the project according to the needs of the multipliers and their groups.
